

AFFIDAVIT OF COMPLAINT

Personally appeared before me Sgt. R. Butterick and made oath that on or about the 25th day of November, 2008, in said County, and within the jurisdiction of the Criminal Court of Shelby County, Tennessee, one Robert Jason Ocampo, age 19sex M, whose last known address is 5015 Brunswick, did unlawfully commit the offense(s) of Reckless Endangerment, TCA 39-13-103 and the essential facts constituting said offense(s) and the source of the affiant's information are as follows: On 11/24/08 at about 15:15 Hours, R. Jason Ocampo was deer hunting in the area of the Loosahatchie River north of Germantown and Old Brownsville roads. Ocampo was walking on a gravel road under the TVA power easement when he heard an animal squeal and heard movement in the bushes off the west side of the road. Ocampo fired his 30-06 rifle in the direction of the noise. Ocampo did not know what he was shooting at Jay Wahlig was checking his racoon traps along the same gravel road and was coming out of a ditch when he was hit in the shoulder by a bullet. Ocampo and his friend Frank Domino helped Wahlig to Germantown north of Old Brownsville and called for help. Wahlig was transported to The MED with perforating gunshot wound to the shoulder.
