Several injured in Tunica bus crash

Nine people were injured Sunday afternoon when a bus and car collided in Tunica County.

About 3:30 p.m., a Grand Casino bus heading south on Highway 61 hit a car that had apparently pulled out in front of the bus from the Casino Center road, Tunica County Sheriff's Department spokesman Larry Liddell said.

The driver of the car and a bus passenger were taken to the Regional Medical Center at Memphis, although their conditions were unknown late Sunday. Seven other people were treated and released from Baptist Memorial Hospital-DeSoto, Liddell said.

The accident remains under investigation.
