AG: Nursing Home Worker Charged With Felony Abuse

JACKSON, Miss. (AP) -- Authorities say a Jackson nursing home worker has been charged with felony abuse of a vulnerable adult.

Attorney General Jim Hood said Tuesday that 38 year-old Nicole A. Williams was indicted by a Hinds County Grand Jury.

Hood says Williams was working as a certified nursing assistant at Manhattan Nursing Home in Jackson when she allegedly "struck the patient, an elderly woman, in the eye."

If convicted, Williams faces up to 20 years

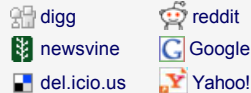
in prison and up to a \$1,000 fine.

A message left for the facility's administrator was not immediately returned. A telephone listing for a Nicole A. Williams in Jackson was disconnected. It's not clear if she's hired and attorney.
